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2022 Tournament Eligibility (Player) - This page does not need to be submitted

The Little League rule book states:

Players are eligible for Tournament Play, provided they meet the criteria established by the Little League "Residency Eligibility Requirement", "Participation in Other Programs" and the following:

Seniors - Any player League Age 13-16, who has participated as an eligible player in 60 percent of the regular season games as of June 15 on Seniors or Juniors Baseball team, with the exception of the school baseball season.

Juniors - Any player League Age 12-14, who has participated as an eligible player in 60 percent of the regular season games as of June 15 on a Juniors or Intermediate Baseball team, with the exception of the school baseball season.

Intermediate - Any player League Age 11-13, who has participated as an eligible player in 60 percent of the regular season games as of June 15 on an Juniors or Intermediate Baseball team, with the exception of the school baseball season.

Little League (Majors Division) - Any player League Age 10-12, who has participated as an eligible player in 60 percent of the regular season games as of June 15 on an Intermediate or Little League Baseball (Majors Division) team, with the exception of the school baseball season.

10-11 Year Old Division - Any player League Age 9-11, who has participated as an eligible player in 60 percent of the regular season games as of June 15, with the exception of the school baseball season, on a:

- 1. Intermediate baseball team, or
- 2. Little League (Majors Division) team, or
- 3. Minor League baseball team.

9-10 Year Old Division - Any player League Age 8-10, who has participated as an eligible player in 60 percent of the regular season games as of June 15, with the exception of the school baseball season, on a:

- 1. Little League (Majors Division) team, or
- 2. Minor League baseball team.

Residency Eligibility Requirement (most likely collected at registration time):

Each local Little League determines the actual geographic boundaries of the area from within which it shall select players. These boundaries must be described in detail and shown on a map and dated when making application for a Little League charter. Players will be eligible to play with that league only if they reside within the boundaries provided to and approved by Little League Baseball, Incorporated.

A player will be deemed to reside within the league boundaries if:

- A. His/her parents are living together and are residing within such league boundaries, OR;
- B. Either of the player's parents (or his/her court-appointed legal guardian) reside within such boundaries. It is unacceptable if a parent moves into a league's boundaries for the purpose of qualifying for tournament play. As detailed later in these rules, the penalty for violation of this rule may, in Little League Baseball, Incorporated's discretion, result in the disqualification of a player, team or entire league from regular season and/or tournament play.

"Residence", "reside" and "residing" refers to a place of bona fide continuous habitation. A place of residence once established shall not be considered changed unless the parents, parent or guardian makes a bona fide change of residence.

A Little League school enrollment for or one document from each of the following groups must be provided to the league:

GROUP ONE

- 1. Driver's License
- 2. School records
- Vehicle records (i.e., registration, lease, etc.)
- 4. Employment records
- Insurance documents

GROUP TWO

- Welfare/child care records
- Federal records (Federal Tax, Social Security, etc.)
- State records
- 4. Local (municipal) records
- Support payment records
- Homeowner or tenant records
- 7. Military records

GROUP THREE

- Voter's Registration
- Utility bills (i.e., gas, electric, water/ sewer, phone, mobile phone, heating, waste disposal)
- Financial records (i.e. loan, credit, investments, etc.)
- Medical records
- Internet, cable, or satellite records

NOTE: Example - Three documents from the same Group (utility bill, cable bill, and bank statement) constitute only ONE document. Any documents submitted as proof of residence must show customary usage or consumption to demonstrate bona fide continuous habitation as determined by Little League Baseball, Incorporated in its discretion.

Proof of Age: A birth certificate will be used to prove the league age of each player. A certified (original) birth certificate must be available if the player is selected.
